

Transfer Certificate Requirements

- 1. A Transfer Certificate (TC) is required to complete a student's registration with the KHDA, the Dubai governing body under the UAE Ministry of Education.
- 2. The Transfer Certificate (TC) must be in English or Arabic.
- <u>3.</u> The layout of the document does not have to match the sample below, but should contain the mentioned fields, be on a school letterhead, signed and stamped by the school. Additional attestations may be required.

Please make sure the Transfer Certificate (TC) states:

• which grade the student was promoted to at the end of the academic year (if enrolling in August/September),

or

• which grade the student is currently enrolled in (if enrolling in midyear)

For a midyear start

All students enrolling in $\bf Pre-KG, KG1$ and $\bf KG2$ that are coming from a nursery <u>do not</u> require a transfer certificate.

All students enrolling in **Pre-KG, KG1 and KG2** that are coming from a school in the UAE <u>must</u> submit a KHDA leaving certificate.

All students enrolling in **Grades 2 to 11** must submit a transfer certificate.
